BARFOOT AND NEVA HICKS BARFOOT, hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with the improvements thereon, lying and situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, shown and designated as Lots No. 46 and the western one-half (1/2) of Lot No. 45 of the plat of Edwards Forest, Section 4, dated December 1965, prepared by C. O. Riddle. Said plat is recorded in the RIC Office for Greenville County and according to said plat has the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 46 and 47 of said plat and running, thence N 40-05 W 198.4 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N 54-24 E 150.3 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 40-03 E 190 feet to an iron pin in the right-of-way of Elwood Drive; thence turning and running S 49-57 W 150 feet to the point of beginning.

THIS conveyance is made subject to all restrictions, setback lines, roadways, zoning ordinances, easements and rights-of-way appearing on the property and/or of record.
