ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southwestern side of Crestone Drive (formerly King Street), and being known and designated as one-half of Lot 20 and all of Lot 19 according to a plat entitled "Westview Heights" prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated July, 1925, and recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C.
