property, or the income therefrom. By this instrument the Grantor intends  
to and does hereby relinquish absolutely and forever all possession or enjoyment  
of, or right to the income from, the trust property, whether directly, indirectly,  
or constructively, and every interest of any nature, present or future, in the  
trust property.
