- (b) To sell, contract to sell, mortgage, encumber, exchange, lease or rent for any term, grant options to purchase or otherwise deal in and dispose of any real estate in which I now have or may hereafter acquire any right, title or interest, whether such real estate be owned in joint tenancy, tenancy in common or in any other manner or capacity, and in my name, or jointly with any other party or parties, including my Attorneys-in-Fact, on such terms, conditions and considerations as my Attorneys-in-Fact shall deem proper; to sign, seal, execute, acknowledge and deliver any and all instruments in writing of any kind and nature, as may be necessary, containing such terms and conditions, and such warranties and covenants, if any, as my said Attorneys-in-Fact shall deem advisable to carry out such powers.
- (c) To manage, utilize, conserve, demolish, repair, rebuild, alter or improve any real estate or structure thereon, owned or claimed to be owned by me in whole or in part, and to protect the same by action, proceeding or otherwise, including but not limited to, the recovery of possession thereof and the removal of tenants or other persons, animals or objects therefrom.
