Granting and giving unto the said Attorney in Fact, full authority and power to do and perform any and all other acts necessary or incidental to the performance and execution of the powers herein expressly granted with power to do and perform all acts authorized hereby, as fully to all intents and purposes as the Grantor might or could do if present with full power of substitution.

The provisions of this Power of Attorney shall continue in full force and effect until revoked.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate.
