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and holding possession of any lands, tenements, rents or real estate, goods and chattels, debts, interest, demands, duties, sum or sums of money or any other thing whatsoever, in any County in the State of South Carolina, as aforesaid, that is, are or shall be by my said attorney thought to be due, owing, belonging to or payable to me in my own right or otherwise; and also for me and in my name, place and stead to appear, answer and defend in all actions and suits whatsoever which shall be commenced against me; and also for me and in my name to compromise, settle and adjust, with each and every person or persons, all actions, accounts, dues and demands, subsisting or to subsist between me and them or any of them, and in such manner as my said attorney shall think proper; hereby giving to my said attorney power and authority to do, execute, and perform and finish for me and in my name all and singular those things which shall be expedient and necessary, or which my said attorney shall judge expedient and necessary in and about or concerning the premises, or any of them, as fully as I, the said Ethel R. Jenkins, could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming whatever my said attorney shall do or cause to be done in, about of concerning the premises, and any part thereof.

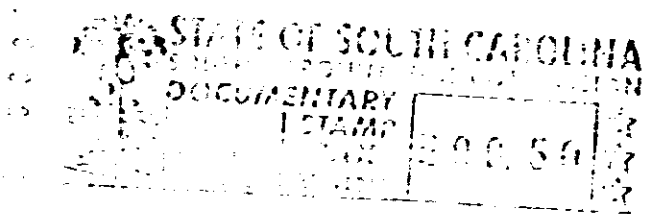
