All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of two lots located about two and one-half miles west of old Greenville County Courthouse, near the Easley Bridge Road, and being a portion of Lots Nos. 20 and 22 of Block C on plat of property of Julia D. Charles, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at page 209 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Gordon Street, which stake is 150 feet east of the intersection of Gordon Street and Texas Avenue, and running thence with Gordon Street N. 71 E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of the other property of S. F. Floyd; thence in a southerly direction 160 feet to a stake on line of Lot No. 18, which point is 87.23 feet in a westerly direction from the common corner of Lots Nos. 18, 19, 20 and 21, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 18 S. 71 W. 45 feet to a stake; thence N. 22-10 W. 160 feet to a stake at the beginning corner.
