

to any trust funds which I may have established, revocable or irrevocable, funded or unfunded;

11. To establish trust funds, revocable or irrevocable, funded or unfunded, for the benefit of me, my children and my lineal descendants, and to transfer any of my assets to such trusts;

12. To enter any safe deposit box either in my name or jointly with another, and to inventory same, and withdraw anything from said safe deposit box.

13. To renounce and waive my right to dower on any deeds, mortgages, devises, inheritances, or other documents.

14. To purchase for my benefit and in my behalf United States Government bonds redeemable at par in payment of United States estate taxes imposed at my death upon my estate.

This power of attorney shall remain in full force and effect until I have revoked it by written instrument recorded in the public records of the County aforesaid. This power of attorney may be amended by me at any time and from time to time. Any person named herein as attorney in fact may be removed by written instrument executed by me and recorded in the public records of the County aforesaid. All references to attorney in fact shall include the plural as well as the singular, and the feminine, masculine and neuter genders.

Notwithstanding any provision herein to the contrary, my attorney in fact shall have no power or authority whatever with respect to (a) any policy of insurance owned by me on the life of my attorney in fact, and (b) any trust created by my attorney in fact as to which I am a Trustee.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney in fact full power and authority to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers herein being in

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
