S.C. Know All Men by These Presents:

The said Eyl R. Martin, and Thomas R. Martin, hereafter referred to as Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, DOLLARS, paid to Grantor by American Service Corporation of S.C., hereafter referred to as Grantee, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grantee its successors or assigns:

ALL that lot of land situate on the northwestern side of Roxbury Terrace (formerly known as Woodland Way), in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina being shown as Lots 2, 3, 4 and a major portion of Lot 1 on a plat of the Terrace Apartments, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1954, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book GG at Page 97 and having according to said plat and a survey made by H. C. Clarkson and R. K. Campbell, Surveyors, June 11, 1965, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Roxbury Terrace, said pin being located 137.7 feet in a westerly direction from an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of McDaniel Avenue and Roxbury Terrace and runs thence along line of other property of John W. Norwood, III, et al, N. 27-24 W., 69.05 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 61-49 W., 26 feet to iron pin; thence S. 73-30 W., 52 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 61-15 W., 117 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 43-0 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-10 W., 133 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 40-15 W., 32 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 5, S. 52-38 E., 155 feet to an iron pin on Roxbury Terrace; thence along Roxbury Terrace, the following courses and distances: N. 31-11 E., 19.7 feet; N. 28-47 E., 50 feet; N. 39-24 E., 32 feet; N. 34-47 55.1 feet; N. 49-19 E., 54.7 feet; N. 46-58 E., 76.6 feet; N. 52-0 E., 22.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Roxbury Terrace (the chord being N. 60-45 E., 83.9 feet) to the beginning corner.
