GENERAL DURABLE
POWER OF ATTORNEY

Know all Men by These Presents, that I, Earline O. Waddell,
also known as _____, a citizen of the State and County
aforesaid, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make,
constitute and appoint, Henry B. Waddell, Jr. of Taylor, S.C.
_____, my true lawful attorney, for me in my name, place
and stead to ask, demand, sue for, collect and receive all sums of money, dividends,
interest, payments on account of debts and legacies and all property now due or
which may hereafter become due and owing to me, and give good and valid receipts
and discharges for such payments; to sell, assign and transfer stocks and bonds
and securities of all kinds in my name and for my account and at such prices as
shall seem good to him; to sign, execute, acknowledge and deliver in my name all
transfers and assignments of securities; to borrow money and to pledge securities
for such loans if in the judgment of my attorney such action should be necessary;
to consent in my name to reorganizations and mergers, and to the exchange of se-
curities for new securities; to manage real property, to sell, convey and mortgage
realty, to foreclose mortgages and to take title to property in my name if he
thinks proper, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds of real property,
mortgages, releases, satisfactions and other instruments relating to realty which
he considers necessary; to place and effect insurance; to do business with banks
and savings and loans and particularly to endorse all checks and drafts made pay-
able to my order and collect the proceeds; to sign in my name checks on all
accounts standing in my name, and to withdraw funds from said accounts, to open
accounts in my name or in his/her name as my attorney-in-fact; to make such pay-
ments and expenditures as may be necessary in connection with any of the foregoing
matters or with the administration of my affairs; to retain counsel and attorneys
on my behalf, to appear for me in all actions and proceedings to which I may be a
party in the courts of South Carolina or any other state in the United States, to
commence actions and proceedings in my name if necessary, to sign and verify in
my name all complaints, petitions, answers and other pleadings of every descrip-
tion; to make and verify income tax returns, and to represent me in all income tax
matters before any office of the Internal Revenue Service, within the limitations
