This matter came before me upon petition of Petitioner dated January 2, 1981. Said petition seeks to close a certain road partially in the City of Travelers Rest and partially in the County of Greenville, South Carolina being known as Evins Road as shown on a plat entitled "Map of Evins Road" prepared by Williams and Plumblee, Inc., Engineering and Land Surveying, dated May 24, 1978. Answers were duly filed by Respondents. admitting the allegations of the Petition and joining in the prayer for relief. Furthermore, all of the Respondents have consented to the issuance of the order in this action.

THEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, the Court finds as follows:

1. That for many years Evins Road connected Little Texas Road with Pinecreat Drive in the vicinity of the Town of Travelers Rest, South Carolina. This road existed during that period of time when the area was agrarian and in recent years the entire area has changed in its physical appearance and is no longer considered to be an agrarian area but on the other hand is now a commercial and industrial area. That additional roads have been constructed in the vicinity of Evins Road and that there does exist sufficient streets and roads to accompodate the general public as well as any of the Respondent land owners, parties to
