In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the undersigned, owner(s) of the premises described below, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company its licensees, agents, successors, assigns, and affiliated and associated companies, the right of way easement to construct, operate, maintain, add or remove such lines or systems of common carriers or related servs, as the grantee may require, consisting of:

- 1.0 poles, guys, anchors, bearing devices and wires;
- 2.0 buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, splicing boxes and pedestals;
- 3.0 circuits, terminals, markers, underground cables and wires;
- 4.0 and other amplifiers, boxes, equipment and devices.

Upon over and under a strip of land \_\_\_\_\_ feet wide across the following lands (County, State of) Greenville, South Carolina generally described as follows: Easement entering the property at the southwestern corner of the Haywood Road and the M. F. Haywood property intersection. (See sketch on back)

and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, over, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property. **All opened trenches and pits will be restored to prevent erosion.**

The following rights are also granted: to allow any other person or company to attach wires or lay cable or conduit within the right-of-way for common carriers or electric power transmission or distribution; ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth or other combustibles within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all trees, weeds, brush or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area; and no right interfere with or fail upon the lines or systems of common carriers or their transmission or distribution.

To have and to hold the above granted easement unto Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns forever.
