Cox, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and the terms and conditions hereinafter expressed have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto:

JAMES S. ADKINS and WILLIAM WALTER ADKINS, as Trustees, their successors and assigns forever:

ALL that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oneal Township, containing 38 acres, more or less, lying on the easterly and westerly sides of Cannon Road and consisting of all of that eighteen (18) acre tract formerly conveyed to W.
