ALL OF OUR UNDIVIDED RIGHT, TITLE, INTEREST AND ESTATE IN AND TO
THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED REAL ESTATE IN GREENVILLE COUNTY TO-WIT:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with the improvements thereon in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Tract No. 8, containing 1.516 acres, more or less, property of Roscoe Means Estate, dated November 6, 1976 by T. H. Walker, Jr., Registered Surveyor No. 3182, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a cul-de-sac, a joint corner of Tracts 1, 2, 8 and 7, and running thence S. 58-31 W., 288.11 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 64-54 W., 319.91 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55-08 E., 178.16 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of division of Tracts 8 and 7, S. 76-40 E. 391.88 feet to the point of beginning; Together with and including a permanent easement of ingress and egress in and to the cul-de-sac, and, all roads and ways shown on all of the lots, to and from and including Knollwood Drive entrance to Tract No. 3, the home place, the same to run with the land.
