The Tenant shall furnish to the Landiord, upon request, evidence reasonably satisfactory to the landlord that such insurance policies are in effect. In the event that the Tenant shall fail to provide such insurance coverage, the Landlord may (but shall not be obligated) to effect such insurance coverage in the maxes of the Tenant and the policy or policies shall also be in the name of, and fully protect, the Lardlord with respect to such claims. The Tenant shall pay on demand the amount properly paid by the Landlord for such purpose with interest thereon at the rate of eighteen (181) percent per annum, or the highest lawful rate, whichever is less, from the date of payment thereof by the Landlerd, and in case of the failure of the Tenant so to pay, such amount field be added to and become part of the next monthly installment of rent and shall become and thereafter for all purposes te additional rent and the Landlord shall have the same remedies for the collection thereof or otherwise as in the case of default of payment of the monthly rent hereby reserved.
