DECREE

Now on this 20th day of January, 1981, this cause comes on for hearing, the Plaintiff appearing in person and by her solicitor, Robert L. Roddey, and Defendant, having been duly served with Summons in accordance with law does not appear; and same is submitted to the Court upon the Complaint of Plaintiff, testimony of Plaintiff and of Terry Nolen, a corroborative witness in Plaintiff's behalf. The Court doth find that it has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter of this action, and the Court doth make the following findings of fact:

1. That Plaintiff is a resident of Pulaski County, Arkansas and has been such resident for more than the statutory period of time.

2. That the parties hereto were married on May 10, 1968, and thereafter lived together as husband and wife until July 28, 1980, at which time the parties hereto separated.

3. That of this marriage no children were born and none are expected.

4. That the parties are the owners as tenants by the entirety of the home located at 11 Confederate Circle, Taylor, South Carolina, more particularly described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northwestern corner of intersection of Confederate Circle and Brookshire Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 23, Sheffield Forest, as shown on a plat thereof, which plat is of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book AAA, at Page 47, reference to said plat being craved for a metes and bounds description thereof.

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
