17. In general, to do all other acts, deeds, matters, and things whatsoever in connection with the sale of the real estate described on Exhibit A or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in doing all acts, deeds, matters and things herein, either particularly or generally described, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.
