The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot Number 56 of the Canebrake Subdivision on plata recorded in Plat Book 5-P at Page 46 of the RMC Office for Greenville County.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of College Properties, Incorporated recorded September 12, 1978 in Deed Book 1087, Page 164 of the RMC Office for Greenville County.

This property is conveyed subject to all easements, restrictions, zoningcondinances and rights of way of record, or on the ground, which may affect said lot.

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or it default be made in any payment of principal or interest, or any notes hereof or hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the Bank and agrees that any judge or jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the described premises, with full authority to take possension thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court.

4. That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

5. That the Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

6. Upon payment of all indettedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legattes, devisees, administrators executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and containing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
