on their loan from the J.M. Huber Corporation shall be reduced by that amount. From that time, the new principal balance due to the J. M. Huber Corporation with a commercial lender and satisfy the indebtedness to J. M. Huber Corporation.

Howson, Jr., is further constitute and empowered to execute any and all promissory notes, mortgages (to include UCC security interests on personal property that may be required), loan agreements, disclosure papers, and any and all instruments and/or documents that may be necessary to consummate the said loan from J.
