ERSHIP. Lots purchased in Gruceland Cemetery are conveyed by Warranty Deed to the purchaser for his family and heirs, as a burial place forever.

In order that the Corporation may have a correct record of ownership of all lots where a re-sale and conveyance is made, it is required that the recorded deed shall be presented at its office so that a record of the transfer can be made. A fee of \$7.00 will be collected before any transfer of ownership is made on the Corporation's records. The Corporation is governed by its own rectains ownership of lots.

Where a lot is purchased and an extension of time is granted by the Corporation for payment, the Corporation retains ownership of the lot until all charges due it are paid, and the Corporation reserves the right to remove the remains which may be interred on the lot, to a smaller lot equal in value to the amount paid on the original, or to a single grave in the event that a default occurs in the agreed payment.

An order in writing is required of the lot owner whenever a grave is to be opened, containing the name, age, sex and residence of the deceased, and a permit from the Board of Heulth must be shown the Superintendent of the grounds before interment is made. If interment is to be made in the forencon, application must be made before 2 o'clock p. m. on the previous day. If in the afternoon, by 9 o'clock a. m. on the same

Let owners shall at once notify the Corporation of any change in his or her post office address or name. No disinterment shall be allowed except upon order of the Executive Officers of the Corporation, and upon the written order of the owner or owners of the lot, and in every case can only be made under the supervision of the Superintendent.

The Corporation shall have the right at all times to enter upon each and every lot for the purpose of maintaining, cleaning, and policing it.

The Corporation from time to time may lay out or alter such avenues or walks, or make such rules and regulations for the government of the grounds as it may drem requisite or proper to promote the general objects of the cematery.

No consent or approval of the Corporation shall be valid or binding unless the same shall be in writing over the signature of an Executive officer.

No improvement shall be made or monument, effigy, or structure erected and no object or inscription shall be used or placed in or upon any lot without the consent of the Corporation.

No work of any character will be done upon any lot except by cemetery employees or by some person authorized in its behalf, and ao lawns, trees, shrubbery, structure, improvements, enclosures, or excavations shall be put, placed or dug upon any lot except by the cemetery employees as directed by the Superintendent.

The grade of all lots, lawns, and avenues as established or changed, from time to time, by the cemetery and all improvements put or placed upon any lot shall not be altered or changed except by the cemetery.

No trees, shrubbery, or plants shall be placed upon or removed from any lot or pruned, except with the consent of the Corporation, but the Corporation shall have the right, from time to time, to plants upon said lots.

The Corporation reserves to itself the entire control of every tree, shrub, or vine, growing within the cemetery enclosure, whether planted by the lot owner or otherwise, including the right of removal when it considers such removal advisable.

Trees will not be removed to make advisable burial burial

The Corporation will use reasonable care in examining trees and removing those apparently in unsound and dangerous condition or unsound and dangerous limbs and branches of trees, but it expressly disclaims responsibility for damage either to persons or property resulting from falling trees or parts of trees.

No flowers or ornaments or objects shall be kept upon any lot after the same shall have become withered, soiled, or unsightly, and in case of the fullure of the owner of any lot to remove any such flowers or other unsightly objects the Corporation shall have the right to remove the same and in no case will the Corporation be responsible for anything placed on lots or graves.

No baskets, glass, crockery, wire, metal arches, watering pots, glass case, covering, box containing artificial flowers, or any sort of receptacle for flowers, except such as are sunk below the surface of the lawn for the grave or lot containing an inner apartment which may be lifted out while mowing the said lot, shall be permitted upon any grave or lot and all such as are not sunk below the surface of the lawn, grave or lot, may be removed by the Corporation.

No firearms, refreshments, or intexteating liquors, shail at any time be brought upon any lot or in any portion of the cemetery; provided, however, that firearms may be used and discharged in case of a military funeral or on a regular appointed Memorial Day or other patriotic service.
