

injure or obstruct said underground sewer pipe line or lines or interrupt or interfere with the normal and usual service or operation of said sewer pipe line or lines; (2) the area included in the right-of-way hereby granted shall not be filled over, filled in or cut down in any manner which would cause the raising or lowering of the ground grade level beyond the elevation or elevations which exist at the time of completion of construction of the underground sewer pipe line or lines in said right-of-way, except that Grantor may improve or cause to be improved the existing access driveway and construct or improve or cause to be constructed or improved an additional access driveway over the right-of-way and easement granted, provided that such improvement or construction would not damage, tend to damage, injure or obstruct said underground sewer pipe line or lines or interrupt or interfere with the normal and usual service or operation of said sewer pipe line or lines; and (3) no building or buildings or structure or structures of any kind, either temporary or permanent, shall at any time be placed or constructed within the area embraced within the right-of-way hereby granted.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the right-of-way and easement hereinabove granted unto Mount Paris Realty Corporation, its successors and assigns forever.
