

her sole unrestricted judgment and discretion may deem best; to demand and receive, sue for and recover, any and all monies or rights of any nature whatsoever and from whatever source derived that may be due to me or which may at any time hereafter become due, and to give in all respects proper receipts, releases and acquittances therefor, hereby giving to her full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises as full to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney may do.

AND, I HEREBY MAKE, PUBLISH AND DECLARE that it is my intention that this Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of myself, the principal, ALICE M. SMITH which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate; that it is my intention that the authority conferred herein shall be exercisable notwithstanding any future physical disability or mental incompetence which may befall me; that it is my intention that all acts done by the Attorney in Fact appointed herein, BETTY G. BLAIR pursuant to the power during any period of physical disability or mental incompetence, shall have the same effect and inure to the benefit of and bind myself, my heirs, devisees, legatees and personal representatives as if I were mentally competent and not disabled. And further, it is my intention that in the event of any onset of mental disability or physical disability, that my Attorney in Fact, appointed hereo, may continue to serve in that capacity without being required to post a surety bond with the Probate Court.
