the rules and regulations pursuant to which the Co-owners of the Units may be entitled to use the General Common Elements. The rights of each Co-owner to the use of the easements and privileges granted herein shall be limited by all such rules and regulations. Such rights of enjoyment shall also be limited by the right of the Board of Directors of said Association to impose assessments against owners of Units, as hereinafter provided, and the right of such Directors to suspend the privilege of utilizing all or certain of the General Common Elements by reason of delinquencies in the payment of such assessments.

IV.

EASEMENTS FOR ENCROACHMENTS AND SUPPORT

Each Unit and the Property included in the General and Limited Common Elements shall be subject to an easement for encroachments created by renovations, settling and overhangs as shall presently exist or shall hereafter be necessary in order to maintain the improvements on the Property in good condition and substantially in their present form, and for any deviations between the original construction plans and specifications (which were relied upon in part in the preparation of Exhibit B) and the actual dimensions of the Units. A valid easement for said encroachments and for the maintenance of same, as long as they stand, shall and does exist. In the event that any Building is partially or totally destroyed and then rebuilt, the Co-owners of the Units so affected agree that minor encroachments of parts of the adjacent Units or General Common Elements or Limited Common Elements, due to construction, shall be permitted, and that a valid easement for said encroachments and the maintenance thereof shall exist. Every portion of a Unit contributing to the support of an abutting Unit shall be burdened with an easement of support for the benefit of such abutting Unit. A valid easement shall and does exist in favor of each Unit owner to make reasonable use, not inconsistent with the terms of Master Deed, of all walls which may serve as common or party walls with other Units.
