AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

PREAMBLE

- 1. The undersigned, David Pavluk and James D. Woznick, are the fee simple owners of Lots 8, 9, 10, 12 and 13 as depicted on a plat entitled, "Property of Ernestine Massey", recorded in Plat Book 4-F at page 7, which lots are subject to certain protective covenants of record in Deed Book 877 at page 507;
