- 1. One Hundred Foot right-of-way to Carolina Power and Light crossing a portion of the northwestern corner of property as shown on Survey for Brookline Carpets, Inc. by Carolina Surveying Co., dated January 28, 1975 (hereinafter "1975 Survey").
- 2. Thirty-Foot right-of-way to Greenville Traction Company as shown in Deed MMM at Page 217, recorded November 9, 1904. In 1950, Carolina Loan and Trust Co., a predecessor in title, quit-claimed its interests in this and a street right of way to its successor in title by Deed 423 at Page 437.
- 3. Twenty-five Foot sewer right-of-way to Greater Greenville Sewer District by Deed 147 at Page 24, recorded July 9, 1928 (shown on "1975 Survey").
- 4. Twenty-five Foot sewer right-of-way to Greater Greenville Sewer District by Deed 531 at Page 101, recorded August 3, 1955 (shown on "1975 Survey").
- 5. Right-of-way of unspecified width and location granted to Duke Power Company by Deed 145 at Page 2.
- 6. Right-of-way of unspecified width and location granted to Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Co. by Deed 578 at Page 434.
- 7. Ten foot sewer right-of-way to Parker Water & Sewer District by Deed 178 at Page 511, recorded December 7, 1934 (shown on "1975 Survey").
- 8. Ten foot sewer right-of-way to Parker Water and Sewer District by Deed 917 at Page 93, recorded June 2, 1971.
- 9. By Deed 365 at Page 234, recorded November 17, 1948, Brooks Brothers Company conveyed to Brookline Fabrics, Inc. a triangular piece of land. The call on the southern side of such piece was listed as N 70-25 E. 128.5 feet. Plat UU, Page 147 recorded December 7, 1960, shows such call as N 70-27 E 141.4 feet. Such 13 feet may be due to right-of-way to Greenville Traction Co. crossing such parcel, but the exact cause of the discrepancy cannot be determined.
- 10. Rights-of-way to Greenville and Northern Railway and Southern Railway are shown on "1975 Survey."
- 11. Greenville County real property taxes for the current year and subsequent years, a lien but not yet due and payable.
- 12. Such matters as are revealed by the "1975 Survey" and the "1979 Survey" and as would be revealed by a current survey or physical examination of the premises.
- 13. Riparian rights of owners of property upstream and downstream on the Reedy River.
- 14. Zoning and other pertinent governmental statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations.
- 15. 68 Foot Duke Power right-of-way crossing western corner of property as shown on "1975 Survey."
