Highway 253) and running thence S 51° 55' E along the southwestern side of Parker Road 83.1 feet; thence turning and running S 38° 20' W along the boundary line of property formerly of Duncan, being conveyed to Humble Oil & Refining Company 135.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running N 51° 52' W along the boundary line of an alley 106.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running N 48° 08' E along the boundary line of Charleston Road (S.C. C. Highway 253) and running thence S 51° 55' E along the southwestern side of Parker Road 82.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running S 38° 20' W 135.55 feet to a point on the northeastern side of an alley; thence turning and running N 51° 52' W along the northeastern side of an alley 82.5 feet to a point; thence turning and running N 38° 20' E along the boundary line of property formerly of Gosnell, being conveyed to Humble Oil & Refining Company, 135.5 feet to the point of commencement.
