

successor to the defunct Campmeeting Association, does specifically release the property from any restrictions as may have been reserved in a 1961 deed from the Campmeeting Association to the South Carolina Conference recorded on August 9, 1961 in Deed Book 679 at Page 406.

Grantor further acknowledges that the 1961 deed from the Campmeeting Association inadvertently failed to include the southerly portion of the 0.79 acre lot which portion had been previously conveyed to the Campmeeting Association in a 1940 deed recorded in Deed Book 225 at Page 110. As the following Church history and documentation indicate, the grantor succeeded to all rights and responsibilities to the Campmeeting Association and is therefore vested with title to the aforesaid omitted lot.

The three ENTITIES (i.e. the S.C. District, the S.C. Conference and the Campmeeting Association) which have held title to the subject property were all South Carolina corporations chartered subject to the Discipline of the Wesleyan Church and its predecessors, The Wesleyan Methodist Church of America, formerly The Wesleyan Methodist Connection. The Campmeeting Association was originally chartered in 1913. In addition, the actions of the Campmeeting Association were subject to approval by the S.C. Conference. On July 14, 1960 the S.C. Conference voted unanimously that the Campmeeting property be deeded to S.C. Conference, subject to the "Constitutuin and by-laws of said Campmeeting Association." Subsequently, on August 18, 1969, the Campmeeting Association voted to dissolve and transfer "all rights, powers, authority and responsibilities" to the South Carolina District. (A certified copy of the resolution passed is attached as EXHIBIT A.) The corporate charter of the Campmeeting Association was formally dissolved on March 17, 1975. (See EXHIBIT B.)

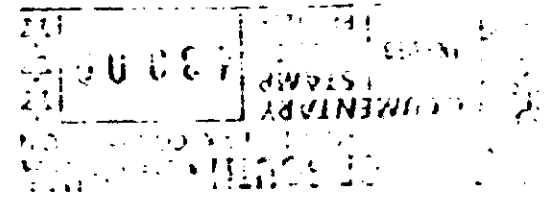
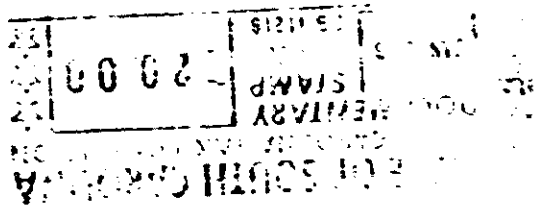
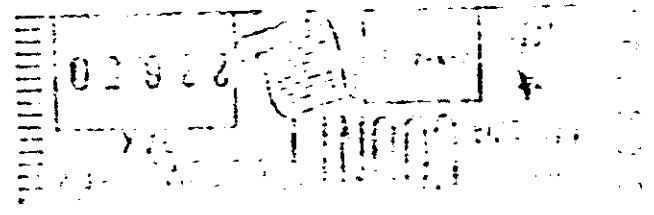
In 1969 the South Carolina Conference of the Wesleyan Methodist Church of America changed its name to the South Carolina District of the Wesleyan Church. In 1975, the charter of the S.C. Conference was formally dissolved and the S.C. District received a new Certificate of Incorporation which is recorded in Deed Book 1024 at Page 361.

Under "The Discipline of The Wesleyan Church", title and control of District property is vested in the District of each state. Under the Standing Rules of S.C. District, the District Superintendent and the District Secretary are the designated officials to execute legal documents in behalf of the District. In July, 1982, the contract of sale between the District and the City of Greer was reported to, and approved by, the District Conference.
