principal incapable of managing his own estate.

I do hereby ratify and confirm all things whatsoever my said attorney or such substitute or substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to be done between the revocation of these presents by my death, or in any other manner, and notice of such revocation reach my said attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me, everything which my said attorney shall do, or cause to be done, after such revocation as aforesaid, shall be valid and effective in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who, before the doing thereof shall not have had notice of such revocation.
