

Said property has the following metes and bounds as shown on said plat: Beginning at a railroad spike in the center of Gibson Road on the west right of way of White Horse Road and running thence along the center of Gibson Road S 50-11 W 330.13 feet to a nail and cap; thence along the center of Gibson Road S 53-41 W 248.96 feet to a nail and cap; thence along the center of Gibson Road S 55-14 W 85.46 feet to a nail and cap in the center of a power line right of way, joint corner of Greenville County School District; thence along the center of said power line right of way and with Greenville County School District line S 35-38 E 342.76 feet to an iron pin on line of Ruby E. Martin et al. property; thence with said Martin property N 24-14 E 288.93 feet to an iron pin; thence with Martin line N 71-41 E 224.22 feet to an iron pin; thence with Martin property N 84-31 E 91.1 feet to an iron pin on the right of way of White Horse Road; thence along the right of way of White Horse Road a curved line which has an arc distance of 357.96 feet and a chord of N 15-48 W 356.96 feet to the beginning point.
