

Several additional hearings have been held, the latest being April 27, 1983. At that hearing, the Court reinstated the contempt sentence and took Robert Marshall Henderson into custody to begin the execution of the six month sentence.

The reinstatement of the original sentence passed by this Court and the commitment of Robert Marshall Henderson to the service of that sentence renders the Bond of Susan Vaughn Henderson null and void and of no effect. Therefore, the Bond is exonerated and the lien on the property of Susan Vaughn Henderson is hereby released.

Notice of the release of the security interests in the property of Susan Vaughn Henderson created by the Bond signed by her on the 30th day of September, 1982, shall be removed of record upon the delivery of this Order to the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County at the Greenville County Courthouse.
