the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto LARRY R. NEWTON & SHERON L. NEWTON, Their Heirs & Assigns, Forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on survey made by Jeffery M. Plumblee, Surveyor, April 27, 1983, as being Tract No. 2 containing 1.5 Acres according to said plat and having the following courses and distances, to wit; said plat being known as Groce Meadow Estates:

BEGINNING at iron pin at edge of Groce Meadow Road at the joint front corner of Tracts 1 & 2 and running thence S. 81-27 W. 591.3 feet to the approximate center of a transmission line owned by Duke Power Company; running thence along the line and right of way of Duke Power transmission line S. 69-52 E. 330.8 feet to a private road (Meadow Lane); running thence along said private road N. 60-22 E. 77.6 feet; thence continuing with said road N. 75-45 E. 145.8 feet; thence continuing with said road S. 88-53 E. 105.3 feet to iron pin; running thence N. 31-41 E. 29 feet to iron pin on Groce Meadow Road; running thence along right of way of Groce Meadow Road N. 27-47 W. 118.5 feet to the beginning corner. INCLUDED in this description is the RIGHT-OF-WAY of Duke Power Company transmission line.
