9. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, ROSE BRAMLETTE WYLIE, which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. It is the intent of the principal to create a durable power of attorney conferring upon her attorney in fact the power to act on behalf of the principal notwithstanding later disability or mental incompetence of the principal, pursuant to the authority of Section 32-13-10 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended.
