QUITCLAIM DEED

NOW, THEREFORE, the County of Greenville, South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to it in hand paid at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) by Piedmont Plush Mills, Inc., does grant, bargain, sell, release and quitclaim unto Piedmont Plush Mills, Inc., all its right, title and interest in and to that certain street known as Dorsey Avenue as more particularly appears on that certain plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Plush Mills, Inc." prepared by Dalton & Neves, Surveyors, dated January, 1974, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book $G_{-}R$ at Pages G_{-} and that certain street formerly known as Benson Street as more particularly appears on that certain plat entitled "Section II, Subdivision for Abney Mills Brandon Plant," prepared by Dalton & Neves, Surveyors, dated February, 1959 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in 14(235) 1/3-1-1 (Note) Plat Book QQ at Pages 58 and 59.

It is the express intent of Greenville County, South Carolina to convey by this quitclaim deed all the right, title and interest which it may so convey in the said street.

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
