

similar equipment used for the benefit of a resident of a lot must be parked in a garage of a dwelling containing a garage provided the garage door is closed and said vehicles or accessories are not visible to persons from the outside.

2.4 No noxious or offensive activity shall be carried on anywhere on the property subject to these covenants, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become a nuisance or menace to the neighborhood. No numbered lot or any part thereof shall be used for any business or commercial purpose or for any public purpose.

2.5 All fuel oil tanks or containers shall be covered or buried underground consistent with normal safety precautions.

2.6 No animals shall be kept, maintained or quartered on any lot except that cats, dogs and caged birds may be kept in reasonable numbers as pets for the pleasure of the occupants. The Architectural Committee is authorized (but not required) to issue reasonable rules for the protection of all Owners in this subdivision relating to pets which may be kept on any numbered lot.

2.7 The total area of all driveways and parking areas shall be paved by plant mix concrete, asphalt or other material provided it is first approved by the Architectural Committee. The driveway and parking area shall be completely paved with the same type of material and materials of a different nature for different parts of the driveway may not be used.

2.8 Garbage containers, trash cans, wood piles and clothes drying areas must be so located that they will not be visible to other property owners.

2.9. Property owners will be required to keep tall shrubbery or hedges trimmed to reasonable limits where air circulation or view from
