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(6) To invest and reinvest from time to time any funds which I may have, in their absolute discretion;

(7) To prepare and file such tax and other returns as may be required by the State of South Carolina and the United States of America, and claims for refunds thereto;

(8) To have access to such safety deposit box as may be leased by me;

(9) And, generally, to manage and control my property and to execute any and all instruments necessary or expedient for that purpose as I might do, if personally present.

And, I, the said JOHN D. WHITTENBURG, do hereby ratify and confirm all acts of my attorneys, and do declare that all acts and deeds performed under this instrument shall have the same full force and effect as if performed and signed by me in person, and this instrument shall be effective until revoked in writing or shall cease by operation of law.

This Power of Attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.
