This matter comes before the Court upon the Petition of Bi-Lo, Inc. and Renosol Corporation requesting that the 520 foot long by 60 foot wide strip of land known as "Bi-Lo Street" be closed and that fee simple title thereto be vested in the petitioners.

I find that the petitioners have complied with the requirements of §57-9-10 through §57-9-40 of the Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina (1976); that the required notice has been published once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in the Greenville News; that the petitioners presently own all of the property abutting on both sides of Bi-Lo Street and on the southern terminus of said Street; that there are no other persons or parties owning or having any interest in the Street; and that proper notice has been given to the County of Greenville and the County of Greenville has no objection to the closing as indicated by the consent of the County Attorney, Joseph H. Earle, Jr.
