west of the ancient Boundary, it being the whole tract of Land containing two
Hundred and seventy one acres granted to the said Robert Gilliland by his
Excellency William Moutt's Governor, bearing date the fifth day of De-
cember one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, and in the tenth
year of the Independence of the United States of America. Together
with all and singular the Houses, outhouses, Caisies, Buildings, barns,
Stables, Yards, Gardens, Orchards, Woods, Underwoods, Timber, and Tim-
ber trees, meadows, Pastures, Ponds, Lakes, fishings, Ways, Waters, watercours,
Paths, Passages, Liberties, Privileges, Profits, Hereditaments, Rights, mem-
bers, and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any-
wise appertaining and the Reversion or Reversions, Remainder and
Remainders, Rents, Issues, and Profits thereof and of Every part and
Parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Plantation or tract of Land con-
taining two hundred and seventy one acres, with Every the Premises and
Appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said William Pike his heirs,
Executors administrators and assigns from the day next before the day
of the date of these Presents for and during and unto the full End and term
of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be completed
and ended Yielding and Paying therefore unto the said Robert Gil-
iland the Rent of one pecked corn on the last day of the said term
if the same shall be lawfully demanded to the Intent and purpose
that by Virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for trans-
ferring of uses into possession he the said William Pike may be in actual
Possession of all and singular the Premises above mentioned with Every
the appurtenances thereunto belonging and thereby be the better Enabled
to have take and Receive the Reversion and Inheritance thereof, which is
Intended to be to him and his heirs, granted and Released by the said Ro-
bert Gilliland by another Indenture Intended to be made and dated
the day next after the day of the date of these Presents, In Witness wh-
