 Year of the American Independence, Between Drury Smith in Laurens  
 County Ninety six District of the One part, and James McEane of the same  
 place of the Other part Witnesseth that the said Drury Smith for and in con-  
 sideration of the sum of ten Shillings Sterling money of the state aforesaid to  
 him in hand paid at and before the sealing and Delivery of these presents  
 the Receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge, hath granted, Bargained,  
 Sold, and Aliened Remised Released and Confirmed unto the said James  
 McEane In his Actual possession now being by Virtue of a Bargain &  
 Sale to him thereof made for one whole year by Indenture of Lease  
 bearing date next the day next before the day of the date hereof and by  
 Virtue and force of the Statute for transferring of uses into possession and  
 to his heirs and assigns all that part of a tract of Land <sup>portaining</sup> One Hundred and  
 Eighty Six acres situate lying and being on both sides the Reedy fork  
 of Reedy River, Bounded on Abner Bishops land to the NW and Michael  
 Purples land to the SE granted unto the said Drury Smith, by the states  
 Patent and under the hand of William Mouttrie Esquire the then Gove-  
 nor bearing date the Eighth day of October 1705 and hath such Single  
 forms and marks as the Plat thereof Directs to the Original Grant annexed  
 Together with all and singular that part of the said tract beginning at a  
 Corner post oak N side of said Reedy fork on Abner Bishops line  
 from thence SW 30.° crossing the creek 63 chains 50 links to a corner  
 Stake, thence NW 50.° 24 chains to a corner post oak on Michael Purples
