A Decree of Conveyance for one hundred acres of Land from Aaron Kemp to Moses Kemp Proved in Court by the oaths of Eli Norman & Pleasant Hudson, the same was ordered to be Recorded.

This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six. Between Aaron Kemp of South Carolina State and County of Greenville of the one part, and Moses Kemp of the State and County aforesaid, Witness that the said Aaron Kemp for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Moses Kemp at and before the sealing and delivery of the presents, have granted, bargained and sold, aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said Moses Kemp his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and on both sides of Brushy Creek of the waters of the Enoree south side and hath such Buttings and shapes as follows to wit, Beginning at a tree called Run N.E. 300 paces to a post oak, thence S.E. 90 poles to a stake,
