
This Indenture made this Eighteenth day of February and in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight. Between James Wright of the County of Spartanburgh and State of South Carolina Planter of the one part, and Thomas Brasure of Greenville County and State of said South Carolina Planter of the other part. Witneseth that the said James Wright for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten pounds Good and lawful money of the state aforesaid to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Thomas Brasure and before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the said James Wright doth hereby Acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the

Said Thomas Brasure his heirs and assigns and for divers other good Causes and Considerations herunto moving have Granted Bargained Sold Alien'd Enfeoffed and Confirmed. and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Thomas Brasure his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land lying & being in the district of Ninety six and in Greenville County on Cripple Creek waters of Reedy River containing five hundred acres Originally Granted to James Wright and signed by his Excellency Benjamin Guerard on the twenty first day January 1785 by a plat and Grant annexed will fully appear. Together with all and singular the Houses. Outhouses. Ways. Waters. Paths. Passages. Trees Fences Enclosures Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel or tract of land so described as above belonging or in any wise Appertaining and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and the Estate right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever both in law and Equity of the said James Wright of in and to the said premises and of in and to every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said parcel or tract of land and all and singular other the premises above mentioned with the Appurtenances unto the said Thomas Brasure his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Thomas Brasure his heirs and assigns forever. And Lastly the said James Wright for himself and his heirs the said parcel or tract of land and all and singular the premises above mentioned with their appurtenances unto the said Thomas Brasure and his heirs and assigns against all persons whatsoever will warrant and forever defend.
