Witnesseth that the said Reuben Stringer for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Henry Langford the receipt whereof the said Reuben Stringer doth hereby acknowledge Hee the said Reuben Stringer hath Granted Bargained and sold aliened and
