Witnesseth that the said Solomon King for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said William Tubb at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is here by Acknowledged, Granted Bargained Sold Aliened incorpored Conveyed and Confirmed and by these presents doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien incorpored Conveyed and Confirmed unto the said William Tubb his heirs and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land Lying situate in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina District of Ninety Six on Tygar River on the south side Surveyed for Solomon King the fourteenth day of May one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five hath such shape marks bettings and boundings as a plot Represents unto a grant annexed said Grant containing One hundred and Seventy six acres, and dated the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and under the hand of the honorable William Moultrie Esquire and the Great seal of the state for that purpose appointed and duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office of the said State Reference thereto had may now fully appear, which said Tract of One hundred and Seventy six acres as aforesaid with all the appurtenances, situate Lying and being as aforesaid with their and every of the rights members and appurtenances, whatsoever and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders of all and singular the Tenements Hereditaments, and premises hereby granted or Intended to be granted and of every part parcel thereof, and all Rents Issues and profits to him or any of them or any part of them Incident belonging or appertaining and also all and every estate and estates Right Claims Interest and demand whatsoever of him the said Solomon King unto said lands, ^{and of} Tenements Hereditaments and premises hereby granted and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of One hundred and Seventy six acres with the premises and appurtenances hereby Granted to the said William Tubb his heirs and assigns and to

his and their proper use and behoof forever and the said Solomon King for himself his heirs Executors Administrators doth hereby promise Covenant and agree that the said Solomon King his heirs Executors administrators shall and will warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said William Tubb his heirs and assigns against all lawfull Claims and demands whatsoever which the above mentioned premises might or may be incumbered or affected contrary to the true intent and meaning of these presents In witness whereof the said Solomon King hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal the day and year first above written

This Indenture made this ninth day of March and in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight Between Lewis Dewall of the said State and County of Greenville of the one part and Noahana Hudson of the said State and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lewis Dewall for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Good and lawful money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Noahana Hudson a land before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged by the said Lewis Dewall and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof To acquit and discharge the said Noahana Hudson his heirs and assigns, and for divers other Good Causes and Considerations hereunto moving have Granted Bargained Sold Aliened Incorpored and Confirmed and by these presents Do Grant Bargain Sell Alien Incorpored and Confirm unto the said Noahana Hudson his heirs and assigns forever all that part of a certain Tract of land of five hundred and forty acres Originally Granted to the said Lewis Dewall and signed by his Excellency Mr. Moultrie on the fourth
