State to the said William Hollens in hand well and Truly paid by the said Reuben Stringer stand before the Sealing and delivery hereof, the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, hath bargained and sold and by these presents hath bargained and sold unto the said Reuben Stringer his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns, all that plantation or Tract of land containing two hundred acres situate lying and being in the District of Ninety Six west of the 26 boundary on the North side of big Saluda River bounding in said River, butting and bounding South westwardly on land laid out to Eason Smith, and on all other sides vacant at the time of the original survey, the said tract of land being Granted to William Hollens by his Excellency William Moultrie then Governor of the said State on the second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Six and recorded in the Secretarys Office in Grant book B B B B page 230 Together with all and singular the waters, water-courses, easements, profits Commodities, Advantages, Emoluments, Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or Tract of land belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof and also all the estate right Title Interest possession property profit Claim and demand whatsoever either in law or Equity of the said William Hollens of in or to the said plantation or Tract of land hereby Granted & Released or meant or Intended to be hereby Granted and Released with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Reuben Stringer his heirs and assigns forever, and the said William Hollens for himself heirs and so forth and every of them the said hereby bargained premises with the appurtenances unto the said Reuben Stringer his heirs and assigns against him the said William Hollens his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns and every of them and other person or persons whatsoever Claiming or to Claim by from or under him them or any of them shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
