This Indenture made the thirtieth day of November one Thou-
 sand Seven hundred and Eighty Seven and in the Eleventh year
 of American Independence Between Robert Hanna of the State
 of South Carolina and Laurence County Surveyor of the one
 part, and Jeremiah Chandler planter of the other part of State
 of South Carolina County Greenville, Witnesseth that the
 said Robert Hanna for and in consideration of the sum of twenty
 pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Jeremiah
 Chandler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said
 Robert Hanna hath bargained and sold and these presents doth
 bargain and sell all that plantation tract of one hundred acres
 of land being granted unto the said Robert Hanna from under
 the hand and seal of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard and

Commander in Chief laid lying or brushy Creek of Reedy River above
 the antient boundary line vacant on all sides when it was surveyed
 and now bounded on three lines by a new Survey made by the ~~ward~~
 above Jeremiah Chandler all containing one hundred acres be the
 same more or less, Together with all and singular the houses
 Edifices out houses Orchards trees woods underwoods ways wa-
 ters watercourses hereditaments and appurtenances as also the
 reversion and reversions remainders rents Issues and profits
 and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the
 said plantation or tract of one hundred acres of land with all
 and singular the Hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto
 belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Jeremiah Chandler his heirs and assigns for and during the
 full end and term of one whole year from thence ensuing and
 full to be computed and ended Yielding and paying unto the

 Guerard Esquire Governor and commander in chief of the said state
 and the great seal for that purpose appointed did give and grant
 unto the said Robert Hanna a plantation or tract of land of one hun-
 dred acres of land lying and being on brushy Creek of reedy river
 above the antient boundary line bounded on all sides on vacant
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
