25) South Carolina Greenville County February the Seventeenth One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Nine, A Deed of conveyance for One hundred and fourteen acres of land from Obadiah Hooper to Moses Wood, proved in open court by the oath of Jesse Carter and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this twenty second day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Eight, and in the year of the Independence ~~the~~ Thirteenth of North America the Thirteenth, Between Obadiah Hooper of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Moses Wood of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Obadiah Hooper for divers good causes and considerations of the best sum of five Shillings current money of South Carolina in hand well and truly paid by Moses Wood unto the said Obadiah Hooper the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth freely and absolutely give grant bargain and sell and confirm unto the said Moses Wood his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and fourteen acres lying and being in the County aforesaid and hath such shape form, marks, cuttings and boundaries as a plot thereunto represents Situate in the district of Ninety Six on the Riverdam of Enoree River bounded on lines running north & northwest by Turnbough, Southeast by Benjamin Whorton northeast by Moses Wood West by vacant land and recorded in Secretarys Office grant book M U U U with all woods waters Houses, Orchards Gardens, Fencings and all the Improvement thereon being To have and to hold the above mentioned land and premises with all appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Moses Wood his heirs and assigns for ever and I the said Obadiah Hooper do for myself my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns put the said Moses Wood his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns in full and peaceable possession of the above mentioned land and premises with all its rights and privileges to enjoy the same in fee simple without any let Trouble molestation or denial of him the said Obadiah Hooper my heirs Executors Administrators and assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever and I the said Obadiah Hooper do and shall well and truly warrant and for ever defend the above mentioned land and premises against all and every other person or persons
