78 South Carolina Greenville County August the twentieth One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, A Deed of conveyance for three hundred and four acres of land from John Norwood to Joseph Hughes, produced in open court being proved before Andrew Hamilton Esq. and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, Between John Norwood of the State of South Carolina Abbeville County Planter of the one part, and Joseph Hughes of the said State and County of Union Planter of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and thirty three pounds Sterling to him the said John Norwood in hand paid by the said Joseph Hughes at or before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Norwood I do hereby release, acquit, discharge the said Joseph Hughes his heirs administrators and assigns by these presents do bargain sell and alien ^{remise} release convey and confirm unto the said Joseph Hughes his heirs Executors administrators and assigns by these presents that tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville County on the North side of the South fork of Saluda about a mile above the forks, beginning at Highway running NE on lands laid out to Col. Anderson Esq SE on vacant lands etc on lands the owner not known etc on vacant land when surveyed and hath such shapes forms and marks as appears by a plat and grant thereunto annexed being granted by his Excel: Genl Benjamin Guerard to the said John Norwood bearing date the July day the 16th day and the year of our Lord 1784 and in the ninth year of American Independence the said plat and grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys office of said State reference thereunto being had may more fully appear, containing in the whole three hundred and four acres be the same more or less said lands bounding on said Saluda River, all Houses buildings Orchards ways waters water-courses, profits, commodities, Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining reversions remainders and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and all rights titles profits claims and whatsoever of the said John Norwood of and in the said premises and all deeds evidences and witnesses of force then in anywise concerning the same To have and to hold the said land hereby conveyed and all and singular the said premises have hereby bargained and sold every part and parcel thereof with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Joseph Hughes his Executors administrators and assigns forever to the only proper use of him the said Joseph
