fifty <sup>three</sup> acres of land from Nathaniel Reed to Joseph Reed produced in open court  
having been proved before Thomas Jenkins Esquire, and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of April One thousand Seven  
hundred and eighty eight and in the twelfth year of American Independence  
between Nath<sup>l</sup>. Reed of the State of South Carolina Greenville County, and  
Joseph Reed of the State and County aforesaid, Witnesseth that the said Nath<sup>l</sup>.  
Reed for and in consideration of five pound Sterling to him in hand paid  
by the said Joseph Reed the receipt of which is hereby acknowledge he  
the said Nath<sup>l</sup>. Reed hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth  
bargain and sell all that plantation or tract of three hundred and fifty  
three acres of land being the said tract granted unto Nath<sup>l</sup>. Reed by pa-  
tent bearing date the fifth of June one thousand Seven hundred and  
eighty six lying and binding on a creek called Rocky Creek in the State  
aforesaid and District of ninety six now called Greenville County  
recorded in the Secretaries office in grant book M. M. M. M page 126  
reference thereunto had more fully appears the same now intended to  
be thus conveyed it being the said tract of three hundred and fifty three  
acres lying on both sides of the main creek beginning on an ored oak and  
runs thence North twenty East boared oak, thence North twenty West to  
a stake, thence the perial runs to the beginning containing three hundred  
and fifty three acres Together with all and singular the Houses buildings  
barns Stables gardens orchards trees wood ways waters water courses com-  
modities and appurtenances whatsover To have and to hold the said plantation  
or tract of three hundred and fifty three acres of land to the said Joseph Reed  
his heirs or assigns for and during the full and term of one whole year  
from thence next ensuing and fully to be compleat and ended Yielding  
and paying on the last day of the said term one pecker corn the same  
should be lawfully demanded to the intent and purpose and by virtue of the Statute for  
transferring uses into possession of the said Joseph Reed may be in absolute possession  
of all and singular the Hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging and be  
thereby the better enabled to have take receive the reversion and Inheritance thereof  
which is intended to be made to the said Joseph Reed his heirs and assigns forever by  
another Indenture dated the day next after the day of the date of these presents.
