South Carolina Greenville County November the Seventeenth One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine. A Deed of conveyance for one hundred and twenty acres of land from Edward Ballinger to Stephen Cantrell. Acknowledged by the said Edward Ballinger in open court and ordered to be recorded.

This Indenture made this Sixteenth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine, and in the fourteenth year of American Independence between Edward Ballinger of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and Stephen Cantrell of the State and County aforesaid of the other part. Witness both that the said Edward Ballinger for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Stephen Cantrell at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Edward Ballinger doth hereby acknowledge He the said Ballinger doth granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Stephen Cantrell his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less Situate in Greenville County on both sides of Enoree River beginning on a post oak on said Ballinger's corner from thence to the head of a branch on said Ballinger's line to a stake corner from thence running a straight course across the little shoal to a red oak corner on the South side of Enoree River from thence down the River to Hickory corner on Nathan's line from thence along said Nathan's line to a stake corner from thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract of land containing five hundred and Eighty Seven acres granted to the said Edward Ballinger under the hand of His Excellency William Moultrie Esquire bearing date the Seventh of November One thousand Seven hundred Eighty five, recorded in the Secretarys office grant book EEE page 504 reference being thereunto had may more fully appear.
