 This Indenture made the Seventh day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and eighty nine, and in the thirteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America, Between Paul Fountain of Ninety Six District and State aforesaid of the one part, and Robert Cannon of said District of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Paul Fountain for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings Sterling money & in hand to him well and truly paid by the said Robert Cannon before the sealing and delivery of hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Robert Cannon his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns tenants in common not as joint tenants all that plantation or tract of land containing two hundred acres situate above the ancient boundary line in ninety six district on Saluda River buting and bounding on all sides on vacant land at the time of the original survey being made which said plantation or tract of land was granted to the said Paul Fountain by His Excellency William Moultrie Esquire by grant bearing date the fourth day of July One thousand Seven hundred and eighty five and hath such shape form and marks as the plat thereof to the Original grant annexed represents reference thereunto being had will more fully appear together with all and singular the gardens Orchards fences ways well waters watercourses easements profits commodities advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and remainder and remainders thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said plantation or tract of land and all the singular and other the premises herein before mentioned and intended to be hereby bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Robert Cannon his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns from the day next before the day of the date of these presents, for and during the full time and unto the full end of and term of one whole year from thence next ensuing fully to be completed and ended yielding and paying therefore unto the said Paul Fountain his heirs Executors or Administrators the rent of one ear of ~~corn~~ Indian corn on the last day of the said term if the same shall be lawfully demanded to the intent and purpose that the said Robert Cannon by virtue hereof and by force of the Statute for transferring uses into possession
