The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Doeg to James Garrison was proven before George Salmon Esquire by the Oath of James Kiel and Record ed this 9th day of June A.D. 1790. 182

This Indenture made the third day of April 1790 and in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty nine between Thomas Doeg of Spartanburgh County and State of South Carolina of the one part and James Garrison of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other Part witnesseth that the said Thomas Doeg for and in consideration of the sum of forty Pounds Sterling Money to him the said Thomas Doeg in hand well and truly Paid by the said James Garrison the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas Doeg hath granted Bargained Sold alienated Released and conveyed and confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant Bargain sell alien Release convey and confirm unto the said James Garrison his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual possession now being all that Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and Twenty eight acres Grant ed unto the said Thomas Doeg by a Grant bearing date the seventh day of May one thousand seven hundred and eighty Seven under the hand of his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esquire Governor and commander in chief in and over the State of South Carolina and Great Seal of the State affixed and duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office of Said State Reference there to being had may more fully appear Situate lying and being in Greenville County on both sides of a small branch of Hush Creek water of Sugar River bounded on all Sides on vacant land when Run out and hath such forms and marks as appears to the said Grant annexed being by estimation one hundred and Twenty eight Acres be the same more or less together with all and Singular the Houses buildings Gardens Orchards Trees woods under woods Fiths Commons commoners of pastures profits commodities advantages Hereditaments ways water-courses and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate Right Title Interest Powers claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Thomas Doeg of in and to the said Tract of Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Bargained premises and all and Singular the said premises
